



Emeritus Professor Demosthenes Bouros, MD, PhD, FERS, FCCP, FAPSR

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SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE

Demosthenes Bouros is **emeritus professor** of Pneumonology at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Medical School, Greece. He served as a faculty member at the Medical School, **University of Crete**, at the **Democritus University** of Thrace, and retired recently as Professor of Pneumonology from the **National and Kapodistrian University of Athens**, Greece.

He was trained at the **Harvard University** and at the **Boston University, USA**, and the **Royal Brompton Hospital, UK**. He was awarded as **visiting professor** at the **Medical University of Vienna** by the **European Respiratory Society (ERS)**.

He is the most cited Greek respiratory physician and among the most highly cited respiratory physicians in pulmonary fibrosis worldwide. He has **published >480 articles (Scopus)**, has **>24.000 citations, H index 71 (Google Scholar)**, is/was member of the **Editorial Board** and reviewer of many prestigious medical journals, including **LANCET-Respiratory Medicine**, **CHEST**, **RESPIRATION**, **BMC series, etc.**, and **Editor-in-chief** of the official journal of the Hellenic Thoracic Society **Pneumon**. Member of the **ATS/ERS/JRS/ALAT** committee for the **idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis (IPF) official guidelines (2011 and 2018 and the 2021 revision)** and the **ATS/ERS new classification of idiopathic interstitial pneumonias (IIPs) (2013)**. Editor of the book **“Pleural Disease, 2nd ed**, Informa, NY).

He was elected as a foundation member of the prestigious **fellows of the European Respiratory Society (FERS)**, is member of the board of the **Hellenic Thoracic Society**, fellow of the **American College of Chest Physicians (FCCP)** and the **Asian Pacific Society of Respiriology (FAPSR)**. He is an honorary member of many societies of Pneumonology in various countries. He is the national representative to European Union of Medical Specialists **UEMS**) for the rare diseases. He has been director of two master degree programs, in **“clinical pharmacology and therapeutics”** and in **“sleep medicine”**. He is an international expert in interstitial lung diseases (ILDs).

He has been elected and served in many official positions of the ERS and ATS. He is **mentor** of many young doctors and **invited lecturer** of many scientific societies internationally.

His main **research interests** include the pathophysiologic/pathogenetic mechanisms and treatment of pulmonary fibrosis and other interstitial lung diseases. Among them is the adipose tissue mesenchymal **stem cell** translational research and the application in chronic lung diseases.
